### End of Life Services and Death with Dignity Kline Galland Hospice

#### SERVICE POLICY

- 1. End of Life Services; Death with Dignity.** Kline Galland Benaroya Community Services, which includes hospice, acknowledges that Washington State law recognizes certain patient rights under the Death with Dignity Act (“Death with Dignity Act”). All providers and staff at Kline Galland Benaroya Community Services are expected to respond to any patient’s query about life ending medication with openness and compassion.
- 2. End of Life Services – Kline Galland Providers Including Hospice.** Kline Galland hospice providers respect the right of each individual to make choices under the Death with Dignity Act. However, Kline Galland providers, including its hospice agency providers, do not participate in the attending and consulting provider review processes set forth, respectively, in RCW 70.245.040 and RCW 70.245.050, which are required to access medication to hasten death under the Death with Dignity Act. Kline Galland’s hospice providers will work to help any dying patient to be as comfortable as possible by controlling pain and other physical, emotional and spiritual symptoms associated with the dying process. Hospice care is provided by members of the interdisciplinary team which includes nurses, social workers, chaplains, nursing assistants, physicians, massage therapists for comfort therapy, music therapists and volunteers.
